Greetings! "Thanks, be unto God for His unspeakable gift" (2 Cor. 9:15). God's unspeakable gift to mankind is our Savior, Jesus the Christ, the LORD. He is the answer to reaching lost mankind. We are so grateful for all those who have gone before us, for those who sowed the seed; those who laid the foundation; for those who walked by faith; for those who did not surrender and did not quit. Blessings upon them all who are now in that great cloud of witnesses (Heb. 12:1, 2).

Christ will one day return to take unto Himself His Bride, which is the Church. In the meanwhile, Christ is working on His Bride, washing and cleansing and making sure there are no blemishes (Ephesians 5:22-30). Therefore for 125 years Christ has been and continues to work on, and within His Church. And so we celebrate, "For

every mountain, you've brought us over, For every trial you've seen us through, For every blessing, Hallelujah for this we give you praise!"




