We are called to love one another but sometimes that love leads to disagreements causing division. Depending on the situation, each person may think they are in the right and therefore there is no need to apologize. It is hard to heal relationships when you think you are always right, and the other person is always wrong. Because of this, I think the hardest words to say after a disagreement are I AM SORRY! No one likes to admit to being wrong, but we must be able to recognize our part in the division and apologize. Sometimes we act like the situation will just go away and we can go

on with life. Then there are other times when the situation is gnawing on us because we are so hurt that we cannot move forward. And then there are those times where we go telling anyone with an ear how we were wronged by that person and that they should now start to dislike that person as well. We get so consumed by our own hurt that we cannot see the situation from the other person's point of view. It is during these times that we need to take it to the Lord in prayer. We can give all the hurt and pain from the disagreement to God and He will direct our next steps.

Apologizing is not a bad thing. When you are a mature Christian, you should be able to acknowledge there was a disagreement and go to that person and apologize. Matthew 18: 21-22 (NIV) states, "Then Peter came to Jesus and asked, "Lord how many times shall I forgive my brother or sister who sins against me? Up to seven times? Jesus answered, "I tell you, not seven times, but seventy-seven times." It may not be easy to say I am sorry, but it will be worth it to get back in right relationship with your sister or brother.

Holding on to grudges not only destroys the individual but it will destroy friendships, families, and even churches. Matthew 6:15 (NIV) states," But if you do not forgive others their sins, your Father will not forgive your sins." We need to remember that if we want God to forgive us we have to extend that same courtesy to others no matter how hard it may be.
