From Our Pastor

Dear Family and Friends of the Mount

Greetings! “Thanks, be unto God for His unspeakable gift” (2 Cor. 9:15). God’s unspeakable gift to mankind is our Savior, Jesus the Christ, the LORD. He, and He alone, is the answer to reaching lost mankind. Oh, we must never seek a “supposed” better strategy to reach the lost than the divine strategy which is, to “preach, Jesus!” Jesus must be magnified. Jesus must be exalted. We deceive ourselves if we think too much of Jesus will be offensive, and so we must lessen our focus upon Jesus. The Bible says, “it pleased God by the foolishness of preaching to save them that believe.” (1 Cor.1:21). No argument. No debate!

It is my joy once more to express sincerest appreciation to each of you, family, members, and friends, for the continuing love you’ve shown in recognition of our birthday. Amen.

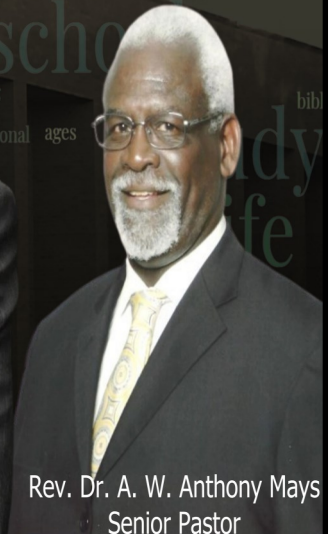

I'm Sorry

We are called to love one another but sometimes that love leads to disagreements causing division. Depending on the situation, each person may think they are in the right and therefore there is no need to apologize. It is hard to heal relationships when you think you are always right, and the other person is always wrong. Because of this, I think the hardest words to say after a disagreement are I AM SORRY! 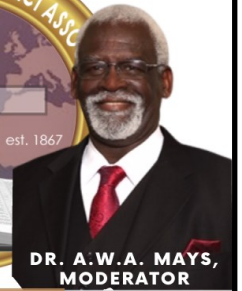
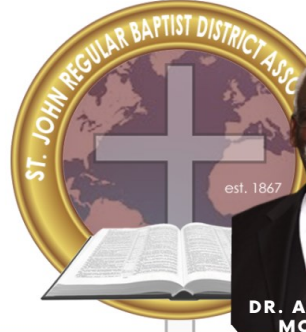

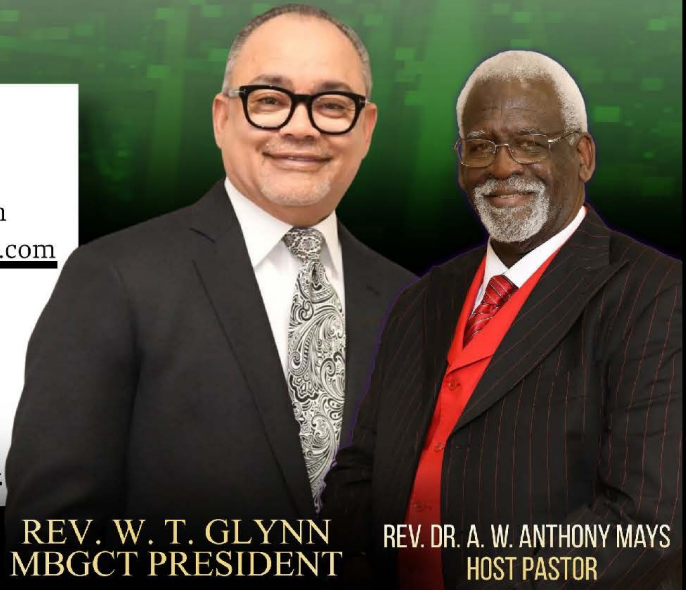
